

# University of Auckland

- The University of Auckland began as a constituent of the <u>University</u> of <u>New Zealand</u>, founded on 23 May 1883 as Auckland University College
- Stewardship of the University during its establishment period was the responsibility of <u>John Chapman Andrew</u> (Vice Chancellor of the University of New Zealand 1885–1903)
- Housed in a disused courthouse and jail, it started out with 95 students and 4 teaching staff: Frederick Douglas Brown, professor of chemistry (London and Oxford); <u>Algernon Phillips Withiel</u> <u>Thomas</u>, professor of natural sciences (Oxford); Thomas George Tucker, professor of classics (Cambridge); and George Francis Walker, professor of mathematics (Cambridge). By 1901, student numbers had risen to 156; the majority of these students were training towards being law clerks or teachers and were enrolled part-time

# Map of Auckland the University








